## 5<sup>th</sup> GIRDER SPAN OF BOGIBEEL BRIDGE LAUNCHED

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Continuing its good work, NF Rly construction Organization has launched the 5<sup>th</sup> all welded 125m span steel girder on the Bogibeel Bridge across the river Brahmaputra. Launching of the girder was commenced at 18.30 hrs of 17.12.2014 and completed at 22.20 hrs of 19.12.2014. This girder is the fifth out of the total 39 spans of 125m to be launched across the river.

The Bogibeel bridge near Dibrugarh with a total length of 4940 m is the longest rail cum road in India. The project with a total cost of 5000 crores incorporates apart from the main bridge, guide bunds on the north and south banks, dykes, road network of 30km, rail network of 74 kms and 6 new stations including New Dibrugarh. The project is targeted for completion by 2017.
